City Stadium Automotive® is a state-of-the-art automotive technician lab where students learn about automotive systems in a hands-on environment while receiving high school and college credit through Northeast Wisconsin Technical College (NWTC). City Stadium Automotive® is located at Green Bay East High School, but students from across the Green Bay Area Public School District are welcome to apply.

City Stadium Automotive® is one of only 14 high schools in Wisconsin to be certified by the National Automotive Technician Education Foundation (NATEF) for Maintenance and Light Repair Program Standards. NATEF is an organization that examines the structure, resources, and quality of training programs and evaluates them against standards established by the industry. Students who receive NATEF certification are prepared to work in the automotive field, enroll in technical college, or both.

City Stadium Automotive® students have the opportunity to work at major dealerships and independent repair centers while still enrolled in high school. The hands-on, real-world experience students receive at City Stadium Automotive® centers around technical research, automotive workplace skills and practices, and preparation for post-secondary education.

Jump-start Your Career

Students have the opportunity to earn up to **27 college credits and a one-year technical diploma** over the course of their junior and senior year as part of the Automotive Maintenance Technician (AMT) program in collaboration with NWTC.



In addition, thanks to a partnership with Ford Motor Company, the Ford Automotive Career Exploration program allows students access to Ford's service literature, web curriculum, and training materials to advance student learning, and to earn Ford training credentials required for Ford dealer technician certificates.
